



The College Council has determined the student uniform after consultation with members of our community. Students are expected to wear the uniform as outlined in this dress code.

*All students are able to select from these items in the combinations stated below:*

Uniform combinations:

- Summer dress with white socks  
OR
- College shorts with white College shirt, College tie and white socks  
OR
- College long trousers with white College shirt, College tie and black socks  
OR
- College pleated tartan skirt with white College shirt, College tie and white socks or black tights
  
- College blazer;
- College jumper or vest;
- Plain black leather or leather look, lace up or T-bar school shoes that have no logo, branding of any sort or any other colour visible when being worn (including on the laces)

Optional

- Black College spray jacket, for outdoor wear only

**Year 12 students** may wear either the Blazer or the College Year 12 Jacket; however, blazers must be worn to all formal school functions.

***Sport/PE Uniform***

College PE shorts or College track pants; College polo top; white socks, lace-up runners; College track jacket. College jumper may be worn with the PE uniform.

***SPECIFIC GUIDELINES***

**(a) Standard Required** Students must wear the Keysborough College Uniform when travelling to and from school. The sport uniform can only be worn on days when a student has PE or School Sport.

**(b) Wearing of the Blazer** The Blazer is an integral part of the Full School Uniform and must be worn to and from school from the start of term 2 until the end of October.

**(c) Tie** Ties must be knotted and tied close to the collar. The tie must be worn with the white shirt – it may be removed on days of excessive heat (an announcement will be made)

**(d) Hats** In Terms 1 and 4 students are encouraged to be "Sun Smart". This involves appropriate wearing of the College cap (no others are acceptable) and the use of sunscreen.

**(e) Jewellery** Any jewellery that may raise concern about safety, be a 'snagging' hazard or pose a chance of injury to the wearer or other students is not permitted. Students with pierced ears may wear TWO pairs of plain gold or silver sleepers or studs, only. Facial piercings are limited to one discreet piercing.

**(f) Hair** Extreme hair colours are not permitted i.e. hair is not to be dyed bright blue, pink, etc

***Uniform Exemption***

If for any reason a student is unable to wear correct uniform a parental note is required and the Teacher Team Leader will issue a Uniform Pass, for a limited time.

***Additional Items***

Students may only wear a scarf, gloves or religious headwear in College Colours (purple, black, white). Scarves, gloves and College hats must not be worn in class (religious headwear are permitted in class). Students may wear thermal layers under their uniform if these garments cannot be seen.

***Not Permitted***

- Non-College trousers, shorts or shirts
- 'Hoodies' or windcheaters
- Nail polish, other than clear polish
- Excessive make-up
- Hats/caps/beanies of any kind other than the College cap
- Wearing leggings/tights/stockings as the outermost garment
- Excessively large items of jewellery – necklaces, rings, earrings, etc
